Arriving at the centre

As you can see from these images, there is a fully tarmacked, 120cm wide path to the main entrance. Level access to the path is next to the disabled parking space.

The winding path has a slight incline, which increases as you move towards the visitor centre.







Our Main Entrance

Access is via a wooden ramp. Please take care when using the ramp as it can be slippery in bad weather.

- Door width: 81cm
- The door is opened with a handle
- Lights need to be switched on by visitors
- The floor is wooden





Getting Around Inside

Visually impaired visitors, please note that there is bench seating in the middle of the floor. There is a glass cabinet to the right of the entrance point. There are no glass contrast markings. Coloured displays on the walls contrast with the stone wall.



Accessible Public Toilet

- Our toilet is unisex and open 24 hours
- It is located just outside the visitor centre at the top of the wooden ramp
- The width of the door is 81cm
- The toilet is 49cm high
- The sink is 74cm high
- There are grab rails next to the toilet and by the sink
- There are baby changing facilities
- The nearest Changing Places facility is in Alford Community Centre
